After prayerful consideration, TLC plans to inform TEAM of their recommendations for ways to expand ministry in West Pasco. A tentative date for a joint TLC / TEAM meeting is set for May 20th at King of Kings at 7:00 p.m. In effect, we will use the data presented to make a plan, and then share with others in a timely manner.

J.C. made a motion to accept the final minutes of the last meeting, and Gene seconded the motion, which then passed.

Mae updated the schools data sheet, and will still research for more details, such as ethnicity.

A letter to the churches was just sent from Ken Aicher, with respect to insurance. Church Mutual Insurance Company has been chosen by Synod. Pastor Jerry and Darrell will also attend a workshop on insurance.

Consulting fees so far have been paid by a Synod grant. Future consolidation fees will need to be paid by TLC, and so a new checking account is being set up, with a goal of an initial balance of \$5000.

Churches will donate to this account proportionally according to average worship attendance as reported to the Synod. The corrected amounts are as follows:
